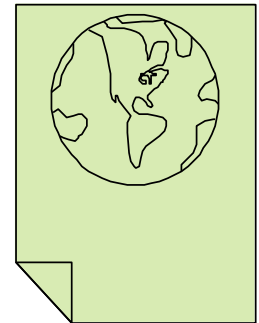

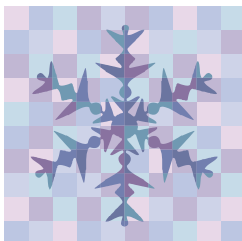
Local Data...



- This page can be used if you are planning a **short flight** where you will remain within **50nm** of a weather reporting station
- **If you are planning a flight out of CZBA:**
 - Local West, enter CYKF for Aerodrome ID
 - Local North, enter CYTZ for Aerodrome ID
 - Local South/East, enter CYHM for Aerodrome ID
- **In the NOTAM Information box, select Weather with NOTAM**
 - You will then get a drop down menu
 - **Select the first two options**
 - Aerodrome NOTAM file
 - FIR NOTAM file
- In the Significant Weather box, select SIGMET and AIRMET
- In the Current Weather box, select any of the first five options that you wish to view
- In the Forecast Weather box, select the first (GFA, both CLD & WX and ICG, TURB & FZLVL) and last (FD <=FL180) options
- Submit and decode your weather

Route Data

- This page can be used if you are planning a **cross country** flight
- Enter in your departure, en route and destination aerodrome identifiers
- Complete the NOTAM Information, Significant Weather, Current Weather and Forecast Weather as you would on the "Local Data" page
- If you wish to view any ASEP Predictions, enter you altitude, departure time and time en route and select the Predictions that you wish to view
- Submit and decode your weather
