

RECREATIONAL PERMIT TRAINING PROGRAM

FLIGHT TRAINING:

- Ⓢ Minimum of 25 hours of flight time
- Ⓢ Minimum of 15 hours DUAL time
- Ⓢ Minimum of 10 hours SOLO time
- Ⓢ Category IV Medical is required and can be administered by your family physician
- Ⓢ The minimum age is 16 years

GROUND SCHOOL:

- Ⓢ There is no pre-requisite
- Ⓢ Our program consists of 16 sessions, held in the classroom facilities at the airport
- Ⓢ You do not have to complete the ground school before you start flight training

EXAMINATIONS:

- Ⓢ A Transport Canada Flight Test and Written Examination are required
- Ⓢ The flight test is administered by a Transport Canada approved examiner on site.
- Ⓢ The written examination is conducted at a Transport Canada office

RESTRICTIONS:

- Ⓢ Flights within Canada only
- Ⓢ Can add float rating, but no other endorsements
- Ⓢ 14 day currency requirement
- Ⓢ Can only fly an aircraft up to 4 seat capacity
- Ⓢ Can carry only one passenger at a time

COSTS:

The ***minimum*** cost for a recreational pilot permit is approx. **\$4035.00** (based on minimum times in a Cessna 152) plus applicable taxes.

These costs are on a “pay as you fly” basis.
