"Co-Pilot" Training



Course Description

This course is designed to familiarize non-pilots with basic aircraft operations so that they may contribute to cockpit activities such as navigation and radio communications. Students will be trained in basic landing techniques as well as emergency communication with Air Traffic Control. This is not an official license or permit, however, the flight time may be credited toward a recreational pilot permit or private pilot license.

Flight Training

- Basic flying techniques and aircraft operation
- Basic landing techniques
- Radio communication and Radio License
- Navigation
- Scenario-based training

Flight Time

The course is based on an estimated flight time of 5-10 hours. Each session will be preceded and concluded with an individual briefing.

Note:

Training can be done on Spectrum Airways' aircraft or your own aircraft. Owner-supplied aircraft must supply proof of insurance to be able to conduct training with the co-pilot candidate.
